Subject: Acceptance of SCLCSS subsidy claims of SC/ST MSEs of Service/Manufacturing sector – Regarding.

Special Credit Linked Capital Subsidy Scheme (SCLCSS) has been introduced under National SC-ST Hub (NSSH) with the objective to promote new enterprises and support the existing enterprises in their expansion for enhanced participation in the public procurement.

- 2. As per the revised NSSH guidelines issued vide OM No. No. K-02/4/2021-SME dated 15.11.2021, Service Sector has been included under SCLCSS component (w.e.f. date of issuance of NSSH guidelines i.e. 15.11.2021). Subsidy of 25% is to be provided to the eligible SC-ST MSEs of manufacturing as well as service sector under NSSH on institutional finance up to Rs. 1 Cr. for procurement of plant & machinery / equipment (i.e. a subsidy cap of Rs. 25 Lacs).
- 3. With the approval of Hon'ble Minister of MSME, it has been decided to keep open the SCLCSS MIS portal throughout the year. Nodal Banks will submit applications on monthly/bi-monthly basis for reimbursement. Timeline for acceptance of SCLCSS subsidy claims for Service and Manufacturing Sector is now open for one year from the reference date as under:
 - SC/ST MSEs of Service sector: Submission of SCLCSS subsidy claims with reference dates from 15.11.2021 (w.e.f. date of issuance of NSSH revised guidelines i.e. 15.11.2021) and onwards.
 - ii. SC/ST MSEs of Manufacturing sector: Submission of SCLCSS subsidy claims with reference dates from 01.01.2022 and onwards (SCLCSS claims upto 31.12.2021 have already been submitted and subsidy has been released).
- 4. All the concerned nodal banks / agencies are hereby notified that SCLCSS MIS portal will be open throughout the year from the reference date as specified in para 3 above. Nodal Banks / agencies are requested to submit applications on monthly/bi-monthly basis for reimbursement under SCLCSS of NSSH claims under SCLCSS will be settled by NSIC with budgetary support under NSSH.
- 5. This issues with the approval of Competent Authority.
